



ASK WILLIE QUESTIONS

I would like to thank everyone who attended our annual meeting on Saturday, March 25. At each annual meeting, Riverland Energy has Ask Willie forms available in which members can ask a question of the cooperative. Below are what we received following the meeting that I will do my best to answer, along with responses from Dairyland Power Cooperative.

The utility is the only business that charges extra for products sold—basic charges—why not lump all charges onto kilowatts used? It seems small users are subsidizing large users. For instance, I buy one 2x4 and pay a \$50 basic charge—the next guy buys max to build a \$250,000 house and pays the \$50 basic charge. Does that seem fair? Adding all operation costs onto kilowatt hours used would also encourage conservation. This idea would show the true cost of electricity.

A. Unfortunately, it is just the opposite. Riverland has a fixed cost to construct and maintain the lines regardless of how much electricity one uses. If the total cost was in kWh charges, a member that uses little to no electricity would not be paying for the equipment and wires required to supply electricity to their service, but would have the ability to use it whenever they wanted, being subsidized by the other members.

From your graphs and reports, it looks to me like capacity is the biggest issue to moving toward renewable energy. What is your plan for increasing capacity of renewables? Has this meeting been recorded? I'd like to re-listen to the gentleman who had the graphs. I'd like to learn more, understand and challenge some of what I heard.

A. You are correct that capacity is the concern. The capacity we are referring to is base load generation. We need adequate supply for times when renewables are not available. We can, and are increasing, renewable capacity as a supplement but not as base load. The meeting was recorded and can be found on our YouTube channel. It is my understanding that there is spent nuclear material currently in storage here in Wisconsin. If new nuclear facilities are built, what plans are made for dealing with nuclear material no longer in use? Is there a way to recycle spent nuclear materials?

A. There is currently spent (used) nuclear fuel stored at three locations in Wisconsin on sites of current or previously operating commercial nuclear power generating facilities, including Dairyland's Genoa Site. The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has contractual agreements in place with all commercial nuclear generating facilities in the country to provide a permanent repository for the spent nuclear fuel;

however, a facility is not yet complete.

In the interim, these facilities have established Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installations (ISFSI) licensure by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to safely store spent fuel until DOE fulfills its obligation to provide an approved permanent repository. As the nation pursues new nuclear generation facilities, spent fuel storage is among DOE topics that need resolution; however, DOE has not yet committed to a specific timeframe.

Regarding recycling of nuclear fuel/material, some countries currently reprocess spent fuel, but the decision was made decades ago in this country to pursue long-term storage rather than reprocessing.

To provide additional perspective on the volume, the amount of spent nuclear fuel is small in comparison to the amount of energy produced because nuclear fuel is extremely dense. In fact, all the used nuclear fuel produced by the U.S. nuclear energy industry over the last 60 years could fit on a football field at a depth of less than 10 yards.

In addition to producing minimal spent fuel, nuclear energy's land footprint is small and produces more electricity on less land than any other clean-air source. To learn more about why nuclear energy is sustainable, go to: Energy.Gov - Nuclear is Clean and Sustainable

I noticed energy conservation and the role it plays in demand for electricity. Conservation is much more than turning off the switch. Energy is the life of a living system. People are part of the solution to having a sustainable, dependable energy system. We need more motivation and education for public support of energy conservation in all sectors of society and the economy. What can Riverland and its members do to initiate more effective energy conservation? Good event – THANKS!

A That is a great point. We offer a variety of energy conservation programs for residential, commercial and industrial members including usage monitoring, energy efficiency incentives, a load management program, and provide energy efficiency tools and advice.

You can monitor, analyze and understand your usage by creating an account and logging in to SmartHub. This helps you to understand your trends to find ways to monitor your energy usage so you can identify ways you can save on consumption.

Our incentive program offers rebates for energy efficient equipment and upgrades. We also offer incentives for home energy audits and follow up with incentives for implementation of the recommended changes.

Our load management program controls the power to residential water heaters and central air conditioners, controlling when the market prices are extremely high or when peak electric demands are at their highest. We also offer credits on your bill each month for controlling your water

heater and AC during peak times.

Our website provides more energy efficient tools, resources and information at riverlandenergy.com. We will continue to work on finding ways to educate our members and the public in finding ways to initiate more effective energy conservation. Thank you for your input.

Comment on Riverland's position on local solar installations: Do or don't you prefer that local solar installations be sized to the owner's electric needs? Excess solar back to Riverland is worth no more than what Dairyland Power charges.

- A. Residential solar projects are required to be sized for the member's annual usage. Riverland offers a monthly banking system with an annual payback at the avoided cost. Any excess kWhs that are produced monthly from the solar are put into a bank. If you don't produce enough solar to cover your usage from Riverland in any given month, you can pull from that bank. You can add and subtract from that bank throughout the year. In March, we pay out all the banked usage at the avoided cost and start over. The avoided cost is what we avoid paying Dairyland, which in turn pays for the solar energy. The avoided cost varies annually depending on the price of electricity in the MISO market.

Has the field of solar panels reduced the cost of purchased electricity? If so, where does it appear on the annual report? Will this help keep the daily fee low in the future?

- A. Riverland is part of three solar projects. In 2022, 8,451 MWh of the produced power from these endeavors was bought and sold directly. This transaction is treated similarly to the purchase and sale of energy to our membership and therefore is part of the "Cost of Power" and "Revenue" lines on the Income Statement. Any net income generated from these transactions does not directly reduce the cost of power, but it can, and did in 2022, increase our margins. This in turn puts less pressure on the need to raise rates.

In addition to the amounts contracted for resale, 3,096 MWh of energy was put directly back to Riverland's system and our membership. Whether this reduces the cost of purchased electricity is much more difficult to calculate. The base rate of energy from Dairyland is much lower than the cost of solar currently, even when considering the addition of their fixed charges. However, during certain seasons, the solar output may offset some of the demand and subsequent charges Riverland would have incurred. Estimating the impact of all these factors leads us to believe that the reduction in power cost is minimal. However, it is a socially responsible endeavor in which Riverland is proud to partake.

In regards to the daily fee, or Basic Service Cost as it's referred to on the member bills, reducing the energy cost will not reduce this rate. This charge is derived from the cost it takes to construct and maintain our infrastructure so that we are able to provide reliable electricity to our membership.

Why have there been so many long-term power outages (4-11 hours) within the past five months? None of these outages (four) have been on extreme weather days. Is the infrastructure getting outdated?

- A. If you are experiencing extended outages and would like to know the cause, please contact our office. We do keep records of the outages times and cause if known. Some of the extended outages are from construction projects going on where contingency methods are put in place to keep the electricity on. This does, however, expose more miles of line that can create longer and larger outages.

How come we are talking about nuclear power again? In the '50s we were told it wouldn't hurt the public. Later years we found out it had big problems for the people. I was stationed at the nuclear test site in Nevada four months for testing of these nuclear bombs and saw many bad circumstances.

- A. Commercial nuclear power is sometimes viewed as dangerous or unstable due to a false association with nuclear weapons, and how it is portrayed on TV and in films. It's important to clarify that nuclear energy isn't the same as nuclear bombs or weapons and the way the energy is controlled and utilized is different. In nuclear reactors, the reaction is moderated and controlled for use for peaceful purposes such as generating energy and the beneficial production of medical isotopes, while in nuclear bombs the reaction is uncontrolled.

Operational safety is the highest priority at America's nuclear plants. With the oversight of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, numerous safety precautions and highly trained operators, nuclear plants are among the safest and most secure industrial environments in the U.S.

Nuclear plants have a long track record of safe operation. In the history of U.S. commercial nuclear energy, there have been no radiation-related health effects linked to their operation. Nuclear power plants maintain the highest standard for operational safety, security, cybersecurity, and emergency preparedness.

In addition to being safe and regulated, nuclear energy is a critical resource to ensure reliable electricity in a carbon-free future. It is carbon-free energy, reliable, cost-effective, and very safe. Simply put, if we are in favor of reducing carbon, we need to be in favor of nuclear energy. This is because it supports the integration of renewable resources and ensures 24/7 power supply. As we work to reduce carbon for the future, we must explore this technology to support growing solar, wind, and hydro energy resources.

Nuclear energy has supplied about a fifth of America's power each year since 1990. It's also the nation's largest source of clean energy—making up nearly 60% of our emissions-free electricity. That's more than all the renewables combined. The nation's fleet of reactors also operates more than 92% of the time, making it the most reliable energy source on the grid.

According to the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI), the United States avoided more than 476 million metric tons of carbon dioxide emissions in 2019. That's the equivalent of removing 100 million cars from the road and more than all other clean energy sources combined.

RIVERLAND ENERGY HOLDS ANNUAL MEETING

More than 450 members and guests attended Riverland Energy's Annual Meeting on Saturday, March 25, at the Arcadia High School. Registration was open and a free pancake breakfast was served from 8 to 10 a.m.

Interim General Manager Tim Holtan started the meeting by honoring the 2022 retirees including General Manager Jerry Sorenson, who retired after 31 years; Line Foremen Mark Schamaun, who retired in December after 32 years; and Pete Boos, who retired in July after 34 years.

During the business meeting, Dairyland Power Cooperative CEO Brent Ridge gave a presentation on sustainability and reliability and how important a generation mix of resources is for us to keep the electricity flowing. Ridge said Dairyland takes a balanced and measured approach in its commitment to reduce its carbon intensity 50 percent by 2030 from 2005 levels. He also talked about how policy decisions have a profound effect on reliability, pointing out that nine states suffered rolling blackouts in the December 2022 cold snap.

"It's (rolling blackouts) a very, very, bad day in our business, and it's not one that we want to get to," Ridge said, adding that this region is moving closer to the real risk of blackouts. Ridge talked about how the Nemadji Trail

Energy Center and Cardinal-Hickory Trail transmission line projects will help ensure reliability, and the decisions that are forcing delays. Ridge said as the utility industry lowers its carbon intensity, renewable-enabling natural gas facilities, such as Nemadji Trail, will be crucial to keep the lights on.

Holtan provided the operations and financial report, as well as an overview of the cooperative's member services and community programs in 2022. He also informed the members that they will see an increase in their bill this year due to the wholesale rate increase from its power supplier, Dairyland Power Cooperative, and rising costs across the board. Holtan added that adjustments in

the form of credits are possible, depending on the fluctuation of power costs.

Board President David Paudler recognized David Anderson for 15 years of service on the board, and Fran Fedie for 8 years of service.

Voting members sent two new directors to the board. Term limits required Anderson to step down after serving four consecutive terms. Steve Hogden of Galesville won the contested election over Daniel Beck of Ettrick to fill the seat vacated by Anderson. Incumbent Director Gary Dvoracek of Holmen won a new term, running unopposed, and Brad Schmidtkecht of Mondovi, also running unopposed, was elected to fill the vacancy of Fran Fedie, who chose not to run for another term.

Reorganization immediately after the annual meeting saw Bea Zingsheim elected president, Dan Filla re-elected as vice president, and Dennis Frame re-elected as the secretary/treasurer and as the new Dairyland Power director.

Thirty-two high school seniors whose families are served by Riverland Energy Cooperative were awarded scholarships of \$1,000 each in a random drawing during the meeting. The funds for these scholarships come from unclaimed capital credits from former members.

The meeting concluded with door prize drawings for those present including electric bill credits, a TV, leaf blower, and gift cards and prizes for kids.

NEW CONSTRUCTION SERVICE PRICING

If you are planning to build a new home or facility this year, please be aware of the increase in fees. Like all utilities, we are experiencing increased material costs due to shortages and economic conditions. The cost of electrical equipment we purchase has more than doubled over the past two years, and the price for some items, such as transformers, has increased up to 75%. These materials have also been in scarce supply, and most manufacturers no longer guarantee shipping dates or final pricing.

As a result, electric utilities face uncertain pricing for materials, and Riverland Energy's Board of Directors approved the policy to increase our new construction fee from \$500 to \$750. Up to \$150 on this new service fee will be refunded upon meeting the following conditions:

- Installation of an 80 gallon or larger electric domestic water heater with a functioning load management control device. An additional monthly credit, based on our rate schedule, will be given for a water heater control.
- A member signs an agreement to utilize the controlled water heater at their location for a minimum of five years.

In addition, the cost for line extension has increased from \$7.50 a foot to \$10 a foot. The first 150 feet being covered by the cooperative is no longer in effect. These prices are effective beginning February 1, 2023.

Our policy is not meant to be a revenue generator nor does it cover 100 percent of costs. It is simply an aid to construction so that area growth doesn't equate to higher rates or that current members subsidize new services. Our due diligence will keep costs at a manageable level, and align us with neighboring utilities and others across the state.
