Hayden Gran and Nick Koval spent a week working to bring electricity to residents of the Navajo Nation in Kayenta, Arizona.

Gran said he decided to participate in the project because he wanted to experience some different work and that it would be a great cause to participate in. Koval said he decided to participate because it is a good experience to help those who don't have power. While there, the crew worked in a lot of rock, using a lot of different equipment to drill holes for poles, and to string wire where they were able to run single-phase lines to people's homes. Koval said, "We were able to speak to a few homeowners.



They were nice and very appreciative of the work we were doing."

Gran and Koval were surprised how many people lived on the reservation without running water, indoor plumbing, or electricity. Gran said "It was a oncein-a-lifetime experience to bring power to people that have lived without it for so long. Every family that we were involved with was very excited and thankful for our efforts, knowing that the future will be a brighter place."

The Navajo Tribal Utility Authority (NTUA) and the American Public Power Association (APPA) began this project in 2019. There are still approximately 13,500 families in the Navajo Nation that still lack access to electricity or running water. Thousands of families travel for over an hour several times a week to collect water.


