Cooperation Among Cooperatives is more than just a saying; it’s a guiding principle that defines the essence of electric cooperatives. At Riverland Energy Cooperative, like many other electric cooperatives, we adhere to seven key principles, one of which is the Sixth Cooperative Principle: “Cooperation Among Cooperatives.” We embrace this cooperative spirit that underscores our belief that by working together, electric cooperatives can both serve their members better and strengthen the cooperative movement as a whole.

In times of crisis, such as major storms, electric cooperatives stand together and come together in a time of need. When disaster strikes one of our sister cooperatives, we offer whatever assistance we can to ensure that their service is restored swiftly. We support each other by providing manpower, equipment, and expertise to restore power and aid in recovery efforts. This collaborative spirit is the bedrock of our cooperative “family.”

Electric cooperatives have a Restoration of Power in an Emergency (ROPE) program in which cooperatives assist other co-ops during emergency situations such as severe weather events, natural disasters, equipment failures, or other emergencies that result in power outages. When an emergency occurs and power is disrupted, electric cooperatives activate their emergency response plans, administered by our generation and transmission co-op, Dairyland Power.

If a co-op is in need of assistance following a major storm, they can reach out to Dairyland Power and activate the ROPE program. Dairyland Power will then go to work to find crews from other cooperatives unaffected by the storm to help restore power to the affected cooperatives.

Recently, we sent four of our linemen

and equipment to assist Alger-Delta Electric Cooperative in Gladstone, Michigan. Alger-Delta is in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan and serves 10,407 members. Snow, ice, and wind caused widespread outages and extensive storm damage to their service territory, leaving over 3,000 of their members without power.

“It’s a good feeling see the lights come back on and see how excited and thankful everyone is,” said Brody Back, REC lineman. “The thank yous we get from them fuels our positive attitudes, even working 6:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. No matter how tired we are, or how long we’ve been working, that feeling always makes it worthwhile, even more than a paycheck.”

In our time of need, such as the spring snowstorm of April 2023, and the wind, rain, and snowstorm that ripped through our area in December of 2022, neighboring cooperatives came to our aid.

Additionally, we also actively participate in regional and national

cooperative organizations, which allows us to exchange ideas, share best practices, and stay ahead of industry trends. We partner with other co-ops to enhance our service to you and the communities we serve. Whether it’s collaborating on right-of-way clearing, after-hours call processing, safety programs, or education and training initiatives, we leverage collective expertise and resources.

In Wisconsin, electric cooperatives join forces through the Wisconsin Electric Cooperative Association (WECA). This collaboration allows us to be an advocate for policies that support our members when it comes to local and statewide issues. By collaborating with WECA and other cooperatives, we have more voices at the state capitol when legislators make decisions that affect us.

RIVERLAND ENERGY ANNUAL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Riverland Energy Cooperative held its Annual Meeting on Saturday, March 23 at the Arcadia High School in Arcadia. The event began with a pancake breakfast, followed by the business meeting. There were just over 400 members and guests in attendance.

Board President Bea Zingsheim called the meeting to order at 10 a.m. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by recognition of veterans and past/current directors of the cooperative.

Niles Berman, Riverland Energy's attorney, assumed chair of the meeting, explaining the formalities of the meeting and reviewing the meeting rules while confirming a quorum of 246 registered members in attendance. The 2023 Annual Meeting minutes were approved without any amendments.

Guest speaker, Dairyland Power Cooperative CEO Brent Ridge, gave a presentation on "navigating a sustainable future." He talked about how Dairyland Power is working to make sure they're doing things the sustainable way by keeping their energy safe, reliable, and affordable while also being environmentally responsible. Ridge talked about



how Dairyland runs their operations, the problems they face, and their plans for the future.

"Dairyland Power is a big part of the local energy scene, providing wholesale power to 24 member distribution cooperatives and 27 municipal utilities," he said. "With an infrastructure of 3,301 miles of transmission lines and 232 substations, Dairyland caters to the energy needs of approximately 700,000 individuals."

Dairyland places high importance on financial controls and compliance to uphold the integrity and stability of

its operations, making big changes like retiring coal units to reduce their carbon emissions. "Even though we have these challenges along with meeting demand, and dealing with rising costs, we're determined to tackle them head-on," Ridge concluded.

CEO Tim Holtan then provided a cooperative report, emphasizing the organization's commitment to safe, reliable, and affordable electricity. Holtan's report covered various aspects including the purpose of the district committee, financial overview, community donations, and key projects such as load management modernization. Additionally, Holtan explained there were no director elections this year and addressed the rate structure changes and the 2.5 percent increase in rates for 2024. He went into further detail to explain how the rate change can affect the member's bill.

Berman was recognized for his retirement as the cooperative attorney for 44 years, with a video tribute from former General Manager David Oelkers.

The meeting concluded with door prize drawings for those present, including electric bill credits of \$50, \$150, \$250, and \$500 and prizes for students and kids. Thirty-one high school scholarships of \$1,000 each, and one for \$5,000, were selected in a random drawing.

Reorganization immediately after the meeting saw Bea Zingsheim re-elected as president, while Dan Filla and Dennis Frame were re-elected as vice president and secretary-treasurer, respectively.
